APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS  
AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Appointment of members of the Committee on Conferences

Note by the President of the General Assembly

1. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 43/222 B of 21 December 1988, the President of the General Assembly is required to appoint at the current session, after consultations with the chairmen of the regional groups, seven members to serve on the Committee on Conferences for a period of three years upon the expiration of the terms of office of Honduras, Hungary, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Jamaica, Mozambique, Senegal and Turkey on 31 December 1994.
2. In that connection, in accordance with the terms of the resolution, I appointed at the 75th and 96th plenary meetings of the General Assembly, on 5 December 1994 and 26 January 1995 respectively, the Bahamas, Belgium, Ghana, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Latvia and Senegal as members of the Committee on Conferences for a term of office ending on 31 December 1997. Regarding the appointment of one member from the Latin American and Caribbean States, I informed the Assembly that I would undertake further consultations.
3. The Chairman of the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States has now informed me that the Group has endorsed the candidature of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines for the vacancy. Having thus completed my consultations, I am appointing Saint Vincent and the Grenadines as a member of the Committee on Conferences for a term of office ending on 31 December 1997.
