### MACROECONOMIC POLICY QUESTIONS

#### Report of the Second Committee (Part I)\*

Rapporteur: Mr. Ahmed Yousif MOHAMED (Sudan)

#### I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 23 September 1994, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-ninth session the item entitled:

"Macroeconomic policy questions:

"(a) Implementation of the commitments and policies agreed upon in the Declaration on International Economic Cooperation, in particular the Revitalization of Economic Growth and Development of the Developing Countries;

"(b) Implementation of the International Development Strategy for the Fourth United Nations Development Decade;

"(c) External debt crisis and development;

"(d) Net transfer of resources between developing and developed countries"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held general discussions on the item at its 10th to 12th meetings, on 18 and 19 October. The general discussion on sub-items (a) and (b) was held at the 10th meeting, on 18 October. The general discussion on sub-items (c) and (d) was held at the 11th and 12th meetings, on 18 and 19 October. An account of the Committee's general discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/49/SR.10-12). Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 3rd to 8th meetings, on 7 and from 11 to 13 October (see A/C.2/49/SR.3-8). An account of the Committee's further consideration of the item will be given in the addenda to the present report.
