SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND INTERNATIONAL
ECONOMIC COOPERATION

Report of the Second Committee (Part I)*

I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 27 September 1995, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fiftieth session the item entitled:

"Sustainable development and international economic cooperation:

"(a) Trade and development;

"(b) Human settlements;

"(c) United Nations Conference for Human Settlements (Habitat II);

"(d) Science and technology for development;

"(e) Implementation of the Programme of Action for the Least Developed Countries for the 1990s;

"(f) Women in development;

"(g) Human resources development;

"(h) Business and development;

"(i) International cooperation for the eradication of poverty in developing countries;

"(j) United Nations initiative on opportunity and participation"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. At its 55th plenary meeting, on 10 November 1995, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fiftieth session an additional item entitled "Food and sustainable agricultural development", as sub-item 95 (k), and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

3. The Second Committee held general discussions on the item at its 30th to 36th meetings, from 13 to 16 November 1995. The general discussion on sub-items (a), (d) and (e) was held at the 30th to 32nd meetings, on 13 and 14 November. The general discussion on sub-items (b) and (c) was held at the 33rd and 34th meetings, on 15 November. The general discussion on sub-items (f), (g), (h), (i), (j) and (k) was held at its 35th and 36th meetings, on 16 November. An account of the Committee's general discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/50/SR.30-36). Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 3rd to 8th meetings, on 3, 4 and 9 to 11 October (see A/C.2/50/SR.3-8). An account of the Committee's further consideration of the item will be given in the addenda to the present report.
